Primary school (LPPS) allows you to connect to the LPPS community and make a real difference!

As a LPPS volunteer, you need to do the <u>RRHAN-EC fundamentals course</u> and keep it current.

- → All volunteers must do mandatory notification training and keep it current. The training is called Responding to Risks of Harm, Abuse and Neglect Education and Care. RHAN-EC for short.
- → This <u>online course</u> outlines the child protection responsibilities for volunteers and provides guidelines on protective practices.
